RE: PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION IN THE DUMPING INVESTIGATION  
OF UREA AMMONIUM NITRATE FROM UKRAINE (A-462-324-000)

1. ON 10/03/2002, THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE PUBLISHED IN THE  
FEDERAL REGISTER ITS PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF SALES AT LESS  
THAN FAIR VALUE IN THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION OF UREA  
AMMONIUM NITRATE SOLUTIONS FROM UKRAINE (67 FR 62012).

2. THE SCOPE OF THIS INVESTIGATION COVERS ALL MIXTURES OF UREA  
AND AMMONIUM NITRATE IN AQUEOUS OR AMMONIACAL SOLUTION,  
REGARDLESS OF NITROGEN CONTENT BY WEIGHT, AND REGARDLESS OF THE

PRESENCE OF ADDITIVES, SUCH AS CORROSION INHIBITORS. THE MERCHANDISE SUBJECT TO THIS INVESTIGATION IS CLASSIFIED IN THE HARMONIZED TARIFF SCHEDULE OF THE UNITED STATES (HTSUS) UNDER ITEM NUMBER 3102.80.00.00. ALTHOUGH THE HTSUS ITEM NUMBER IS PROVIDED FOR CONVENIENCE AND U.S. CUSTOMS SERVICE PURPOSES, THE WRITTEN DESCRIPTION OF THE MERCHANDISE UNDER INVESTIGATION IS DISPOSITIVE.

3. FOR FURTHER REPORTING PURPOSES THIS CASE HAS BEEN ASSIGNED INVESTIGATION NUMBER: A-462-324.

4. FOR IMPORTS OF UREA AMMONIUM NITRATE SOLUTIONS FROM UKRAINE, THE CUSTOMS SERVICE SHALL SUSPEND LIQUIDATIONS OF SUCH SHIPMENTS ENTERED OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER

10/03/2002, THE DATE OF PUBLICATION OF THIS PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION. EFFECTIVE 10/03/2002, CUSTOMS SHALL REQUIRE, FOR SUCH ENTRIES, A CASH DEPOSIT OR THE POSTING OF A BOND EQUAL TO THE MARGINS SHOWN BELOW:

IN ACCORDANCE WITH T.D. 85-145, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CUSTOMS SERVICE, CUSTOMS OFFICERS MAY ACCEPT EITHER A SINGLE-ENTRY BASIC IMPORTATION AND ENTRY BOND OR A CONTINUOUS BASIC IMPORTATION AND ENTRY BOND ONLY IF THE AMOUNT OF THE ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTY IS LESS THAN FIVE PERCENT AD VALOREM (OR THE EQUIVALENT). OTHERWISE, WHERE THE IMPORTER HAS THE OPTION TO POST A BOND FOR ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING OR COUNTERVAILING DUTIES, CUSTOMS OFFICERS MUST REQUIRE A SINGLE-ENTRY BASIC IMPORTATION AND ENTRY BOND PURSUANT TO T.D. 85-145. YOU ARE INSTRUCTED TO ADHERE TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF T.D. 85-145 WITH RESPECT TO THESE BONDING REQUIREMENTS.
