RE: Correction of message IMN 3144302, dated 05/24/2013 concerning the antidumping duty order on saccharin from the People's Republic of China (A-570-878).

1. This is a correction to message IMN 3144302, dated 05/24/2013, to correct the header and paragraph 5.
2. The header of message IMN 3144302 contained an incorrect effective date of 08/30/2012 and an incorrect lifting of suspension date of 08/30/2012. Instead the effective date should be 08/26/2011 and the notice of lifting of suspension date should be 08/26/2011.
3. Paragraph 5 of message IMN 3144302 contained incorrect information about the publication of initiation of administrative review.

Paragraph 5 of message IMN 3144302 reads as follows:

Notice of the lifting of suspension of liquidation of entries of subject merchandise covered by paragraph 2 occurred with the publication of the notice of initiation of administrative review for the 07/2011 anniversary month (77 FR 52688, 08/30/2012). Unless instructed otherwise, for all other shipments of saccharin from the People's Republic of China you shall continue to collect cash deposits of estimated antidumping duties for the merchandise at the current rates.

Instead, paragraph 5 of message number 3144302 should read as follows:

Notice of the lifting of suspension of liquidation of entries of subject merchandise covered by paragraph 2 occurred with the publication of the notice of initiation of administrative review for the 07/2011 anniversary month (76 FR 53404, 08/26/2011). Unless instructed otherwise, for all other shipments of saccharin from the People's Republic of China you shall continue to collect cash deposits of estimated antidumping duties for the merchandise at the current rates.
