RE: Temporary Restraining Order on Certain Frozen Fish Fillets from the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (A-552-801), court number 13-00156

1. On 5/24/13 the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a Temporary Restraining Order (TRO) enjoining liquidation of certain entries of merchandise which were exported by Vinh Hoan Corporation and which are subject to the antidumping duty order on Certain Frozen Fish Fillets from the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (A-552-801) for the period 8/1/10 through 7/31/11.
2. This TRO was issued in connection with court case number 13-00156 and enjoins liquidation of the entries described above. This TRO shall be effective for all entries which remain unliquidated as of 5:00 pm on 05/24/13 and shall remain in effect until the fifth business day after the day on which copies of the preliminary injunction entered in 13-00156 are personally served by hand delivery by Plaintiffs on the U.S. Department of Commerce.
3. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by the TRO have not yet been issued.
4. Accordingly, effective 5/24/13, CBP is instructed not to liquidate entries of merchandise subject to the TRO as described in paragraph 1. Any entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of other entries of Certain Frozen Fish Fillets from the Socialist Republic of Vietnam that were exported by Vinh Hoan Corporation and that were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption during the period 8/1/10 through 7/31/11 until liquidation instructions are issued.
5.
