RE: TERMINATION OF DUMPING INVESTIGATIONS OF COLD-ROLLED CS FLAT PRODUCTS FROM VARIOUS COUNTRIES.

1. ON OCTOBER 28, 2002, THE INTERNATIONAL TRADE COMMISSION (ITC) NOTIFIED THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE OF ITS NEGATIVE FINAL DETERMINATIONS IN THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATIONS OF COLD-ROLLED CARBON STEEL FLAT PRODUCTS FROM NEW ZEALAND, SOUTH AFRICA, SPAIN, TAIWAN, TURKEY, AND VENEZUELA. THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATIONS OF COLD-ROLLED CARBON STEEL FLAT PRODUCTS FROM NEW ZEALAND, SOUTH AFRICA, SPAIN, TAIWAN, TURKEY, AND VENEZUELA HAVE BEEN TERMINATED.

2. WITH RESPECT TO THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION OF COLD-ROLLED CARBON STEEL FLAT PRODUCTS FROM SPAIN FOR FURTHER REPORTING PURPOSES THIS CASE HAS BEEN ASSIGNED INVESTIGATION NUMBER A-469-812. FOR CUSTOMS PURPOSES, THE FOLLOWING IDENTIFICATION NUMBER SHOULD BE USED: A-470-812.

3. FIELD OFFICES SHOULD DISCONTINUE SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION OF ALL SHIPMENTS OF THIS MERCHANDISE ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER MAY 9, 2002. ALL ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES DEPOSITED ON ENTRIES OF THE SUBJECT MERCHANDISE SHALL BE REFUNDED AND THE BONDS OR OTHER SECURITY RELEASED AT THE TIME OF LIQUIDATION.

4. INTEREST PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930 DO NOT APPLY.

5.
