RE: Initiation of antidumping duty investigations of prestressed concrete steel rail tie wire from Mexico, The People's Republic of China, and Thailand (A-201-843, A-570-990, and A-549-829)

1. On 05/20/2013, Commerce published in the Federal Register its initiation of the antidumping duty investigations of prestressed concrete steel rail tie wire from Mexico, The People's Republic of China, and Thailand (78 FR 29325).

2. The product covered by these investigations is high carbon steel wire; stress relieved or low relaxation; indented or otherwise deformed; meeting at a minimum the American Society for Testing Materials (ASTM) A881/A881M specification; regardless of shape, size, or other alloy element levels; suitable for use as prestressed tendons in concrete railroad ties ("PC tie wire"). High carbon steel is defined as steel that contains 0.6 percent or more of carbon by weight.

PC tie wire is classified under the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (HTSUS) subheading 7217.10.8045, but may also be classified under subheadings 7217.10.7000, 7217.10.8025, 7217.10.8030, 7217.10.9000, 7229.90.1000, 7229.90.5016, 7229.90.5031, 7229.90.5051, and 7229.90.9000. Although the HTSUS subheadings are provided for convenience and customs purposes, the written description of the scope of the investigations is dispositive.

3. These investigations have been assigned investigation numbers A-201-843 (Mexico), A-570-990 (China), and A-549-829 (Thailand).
