RE: Preliminary injunction on lightweight thermal paper from Germany for Papierfabrik August Koehler, AG for the period 11/01/2010 through 10/31/2011 (A-428-840), court number 13-00163

1. On 05/06/2013, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction enjoining liquidation of certain entries which are subject to the antidumping duty order on lightweight thermal paper from Germany (A-428-840) for the period 11/01/2010 through 10/31/2011.

2. This injunction was issued in connection with court case number 13-00163 and enjoins liquidation of the entries described in paragraph 4 below.

3. The temporary restraining order implemented in message number 312830, dated 05/08/2013, is dissolved effective as of 5 o'clock PM on 05/13/2013.

4. Accordingly, until further notice, do not liquidate entries of subject merchandise which were produced and exported by Papierfabrik August Koehler, AG, and were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption during the period 11/01/2010 through 10/31/2011. Any entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.

5. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by the injunction have not yet been issued.

6. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to prevent liquidation of any entries subject to the above.

7. Commerce's APO Docket Center was served with the above-referenced injunction on 05/06/2013. Pursuant to the terms of the injunction, no liquidation of the entries covered by the injunction may be made for entries which remain unliquidated as of 5 o'clock PM on 05/13/2013, the fifth business day after the day on which copies of this order are personally served on Commerce's APO Docket Center.
