RE: Temporary Restraining Order on Lightweight Thermal Paper from Germany (A-428-840), court number 13-00163

1. On 05/06/2013 the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a Temporary Restraining Order (TRO) enjoining liquidation of certain entries of merchandise which were produced and exported by Papierfabrik August Koehler, AG that are subject to the antidumping duty order on lightweight thermal paper from Germany (A-428-840), and were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption between 11/01/2010 and 10/31/2011.
2. This TRO was issued in connection with court case number 13-00163 and enjoins liquidation of the entries described above. This TRO shall be effective for all entries which remain unliquidated as of 05/06/2013, and shall remain in effect until 5:00 p.m. on 05/13/2013.
3. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by the TRO have not yet been issued.
4. Accordingly, effective 05/06/2013 and until 5:00 p.m. on 05/13/2013, CBP is instructed not to liquidate entries of merchandise subject to the TRO as described in paragraph 1. Any entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of entries of lightweight thermal paper from Germany that were produced or exported by Papierfabrik August Koehler AG and that were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption during the period 11/01/2010 through 10/31/2011, until liquidation instructions are issued.
