2. THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE (THE DEPARTMENT) HAS PUBLISHED IN
THE FEDERAL REGISTER ON 8/16/2002 THE FINAL RESULTS OF ITS
CHANGED CIRCUMSTANCES ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW OF THE ANTIDUMPING
DUTY ORDER ON IRON CONSTRUCTION CASTINGS FROM CANADA (67 FR
53562). IN THAT REVIEW, THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINED THAT DURING

03/01/1999 THROUGH 02/29/2000, THE PERIOD COVERED BY THE DEPARTMENT'S 99-00 ANTIDUMPING DUTY ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW OF THE ORDER ON IRON CONSTRUCTION CASTINGS FROM CANADA, THE LAPERLE, GRAND MERE, AND BIBBY STE-CROIX FOUNDRIES WHICH HAD BEEN OWNED BY VARIOUS LEGALENTITIES NAMED AS RESPONDENTS IN PRIOR SEGMENTS OF THIS PROCEEDING, WERE ALL UNINCORPORATED FOUNDRIES OWNED BY THE SAME COMPANY, CANADA PIPE COMPANY, LTD. (A-122-503-028)

3. DURING THE 99-00 ANTIDUMPING DUTY ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW OF IRON CONSTRUCTION CASTINGS FROM CANADA, THE DEPARTMENT REVIEWED SALES OF CANADA PIPE COMPANY, LTD., INCLUDING CANADA PIPE COMPANY, LTD.'S SALES OF SUBJECT MERCHANDISE PRODUCED BY ITS UNINCORPORATED FOUNDRIES, LAPERLE, GRAND MERE, AND BIBBY STE-CROIX.

4. THEREFORE, THE CASH DEPOSIT RATE OF 3.89 PERCENT, ESTABLISHED FOR CANADA PIPE COMPANY, LTD., IN THE 99-00 ANTIDUMPING DUTY ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW OF IRON CONSTRUCTION CASTINGS FROM CANADA ALSO APPLIES TO CANADA PIPE COMPANY, LTD.'S SALES OF SUBJECT MERCHANDISE PRODUCED BY ITS UNINCORPORATED FOUNDRIES, LAPERLE, GRAND MERE, AND BIBBY STE-CROIX THAT ARE ENTERED OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER APRIL 12, 2001, THE DATE OF PUBLICATION OF THE FINAL RESULTS IN THE 99-00 ANTIDUMPING DUTY ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW (66 FR 18900).
