1. AS A RESULT OF A NOTIFICATION FROM THE PETITIONERS, THAT THEY WERE NO LONGER INTERESTED IN THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER ON POLYETHYLENE TEREPHTHALTE FILM, SHEET, AND STRIP FROM JAPAN, THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE REVOKED THIS ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER AND

PUBLISHED THE REVOCATION IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER (60 FR 52366) ON 10/06/1995. SEE MESSAGE NUMBER 6290116, DATED 10/17/1995. THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF REVOCATION WAS 06/01/1992.

2. THE DEPARTMENT ASSUMES THAT THE U.S. BUREAU OF CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION ('BCBP') (CUSTOMS) TERMINATED THE SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION FOR ALL SHIPMENTS OF POLYETHYLENE TEREPHTHALTE FILM, SHEET, AND STRIP FROM JAPAN (A-588-814) ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER 06/01/1992 AND LIQUIDATED ALL ENTRIES OF THE SUBJECT PRODUCT THAT WERE SUSPENDED ON OR AFTER 06/01/1992 WITHOUT REGARD TO ANTIDUMPING DUTIES (I.E., RELEASE ALL BONDS AND REFUND ALL CASH DEPOSITS). IF, HOWEVER, ENTRIES REMAIN OF POLYETHYLENE TEREPHTHALTE FILM, SHEET, AND STRIP FROM JAPAN SUSPENDED ON OR AFTER 06/01/1992, BCBP IS DIRECTED TO LIQUIDATE THOSE ENTRIES WITHOUT REGARD TO ANTIDUMPING DUTIES.

3. THE ASSESSMENT OF ANTIDUMPING DUTIES BY BCBP ON ENTRIES OF THIS MERCHANDISE IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT 1930. SECTION 778 REQUIRES THAT BCBP PAYS INTEREST ON OVERPAYMENTS AND ASSESS INTEREST ON UNDERPAYMENTS OF THE REQUIRED AMOUNTS DEPOSITED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES. THE INTEREST PROVISIONS ARE NOT APPLICABLE TO CASH OR BONDS POSTED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES BEFORE THE DATE OF PUBLICATION OF THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER. INTEREST SHALL BE CALCULATED FROM THE DATE OF PAYMENT OF ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES THROUGH THE DATE OF LIQUIDATION. THE RATE AT WHICH SUCH INTEREST IS PAYABLE IS THE RATE IN EFFECT UNDER SECTION 6621 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1954 FOR SUCH PERIOD.
