1. IN ACCORDANCE WITH A COURT ORDER ISSUED ON AUGUST 11,
1992, BY JUDGE GREGORY W. CARMAN, UNITED STATES COURT OF
INTERNATIONAL TRADE, OFFICERS OF THE UNITED STATES CUSTOMS
SERVICE ARE ENJOINED FROM LIQUIDATING ENTRIES OF FISH NETTING OF
MAN-MADE FIBERS FROM JAPAN WHICH (1) WERE SOLD AND EXPORTED FROM
JAPAN BY YAMAJI FISHING NET COMPANY, LTD.; (2) WERE ENTERED OR
WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE FOR CONSUMPTION DURING THE PERIOD JUNE

1, 1984, THROUGH MAY 31, 1987; (3) WERE CLASSIFIED UNDER TSUSA

NUMBERS 355.4520 AND 355.4530, AND ARE CURRENTLY CLASSIFIABLE UNDER HTS NUMBERS 5608.11.00, 5608.19.10, AND 5608.90.10; AND (4) ARE COVERED BY THE FINAL RESULTS OF ANTIDUMPING DUTY ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW: FISH NETTING OF MAN-MADE FIBERS FROM JAPAN (56 FED. REG. 49456, SEPTEMBER 30, 1991). THIS COURT ORDER WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.

2. FOR FURTHER REPORTING PURPOSES THIS CASE HAS BEEN ASSIGNED THE CASE NUMBER A-588-029.
