1. ON SEPTEMBER 5, 2003, THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE PUBLISHED  
IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER ITS FINAL AFFIRMATIVE DETERMINATION IN  
THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION OF CERTAIN DURUM WHEAT FROM  
CANADA (68 FR 52741).

2. THE SCOPE OF THIS INVESTIGATION INCLUDES DURUM WHEAT.  
IMPORTS COVERED BY THIS INVESTIGATION ARE ALL VARIETIES OF DURUM  
WHEAT FROM CANADA. THIS INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, A

VARIETY COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS CANADA WESTERN AMBER DURUM. THE

MERCHANDISE SUBJECT TO THIS INVESTIGATION IS TYPICALLY CLASSIFIED IN THE FOLLOWING HARMONIZED TARIFF SCHEDULE OF THE UNITED STATES ("HTSUS") SUBHEADINGS: 1001.10.00.10, 1001.10.00.91, 1001.10.00.92, 1001.10.00.95, 1001.10.00.96, AND 1001.10.00.99.

ALTHOUGH THE HTSUS SUBHEADINGS PROVIDED FOR DURUM WHEAT ARE FOR CONVENIENCE AND U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION PURPOSES, OUR WRITTEN DESCRIPTION OF THE SCOPE OF THIS PROCEEDING IS DISPOSITIVE.

3. FOR FURTHER REPORTING PURPOSES THIS CASE HAS BEEN ASSIGNED INVESTIGATION NUMBER A-122-845.

4. FOR IMPORTS OF DURUM WHEAT FROM CANADA, U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION SHALL CONTINUE TO SUSPEND LIQUIDATION OF SUCH SHIPMENTS ENTERED OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE FOR CONSUMPTION

ON

OR AFTER MAY 8, 2003.

EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 5, 2003, U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION SHALL REQUIRE, FOR SUCH ENTRIES, A CASH DEPOSIT OR THE POSTING OF A BOND EQUAL TO THE RATES SHOWN BELOW:

MANUFACTURER/PRODUCER/ EXPORTER	CUSTOMS ID NUMBER	AD VALOREM MARGIN
CANADIAN WHEAT BOARD	A-122-845-001	8.26 PERCENT
ALL OTHERS	A-122-845-000	8.26 PERCENT

5. IN ACCORDANCE WITH T.D. 85-145, AT THE DISCRETION OF U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION, U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION OFFICERS MAY ACCEPT EITHER A SINGLE-ENTRY BASIC IMPORTATION AND ENTRY BOND OR A CONTINUOUS BASIC IMPORTATION AND ENTRY BOND ONLY IF THE AMOUNT OF THE ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTY

IS LESS THAN FIVE PERCENT AD VALOREM (OR THE EQUIVALENT). OTHERWISE, WHERE THE IMPORTER HAS THE OPTION TO POST A BOND FOR ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES, U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION OFFICERS MUST REQUIRE A SINGLE-ENTRY BASIC IMPORTATION AND ENTRY BOND PURSUANT TO T.D. 85-145. YOU ARE INSTRUCTED TO ADHERE TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF T.D. 85-145 WITH RESPECT TO THESE BONDING REQUIREMENTS.
