1. ON MAY 21, 2004, THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE PUBLISHED IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER ITS PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF SALES AT LESS THAN FAIR VALUE IN THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION OF CERTAIN ALUMINUM PLATE FROM SOUTH AFRICA.

2. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS INVESTIGATION, THE PRODUCT COVERED IS 6000 SERIES ALUMINUM ALLOY, FLAT SURFACE, ROLLED PLATE, WHETHER IN COILS OR CUT-TO-LENGTH FORMS, THAT IS RECTANGULAR IN CROSS SECTION WITH OR WITHOUT ROUNDED CORNERS AND WITH A THICKNESS OF

MORE THAN .250 INCHES (6.3 MILLIMETERS). 6000 SERIES ALUMINUM ROLLED PLATE IS DEFINED BY THE ALUMINUM ASSOCIATION, INC. EXCLUDED FROM THE SCOPE OF THIS INVESTIGATION ARE EXTRUDED ALUMINUM PRODUCTS AND TREAD PLATE.

THE MERCHANDISE SUBJECT TO THIS INVESTIGATION IS CURRENTLY CLASSIFIABLE UNDER SUBHEADING 7606.12.3030 OF THE HARMONIZED TARIFF SCHEDULE OF THE UNITED STATES (HTS). ALTHOUGH THE HTS SUBHEADING IS PROVIDED FOR CONVENIENCE AND CUSTOMS PURPOSES, THE WRITTEN DESCRIPTION OF THE SCOPE OF THIS INVESTIGATION IS DISPOSITIVE.

3. FOR FURTHER REPORTING PURPOSES THIS CASE HAS BEEN ASSIGNED INVESTIGATION NUMBER A-791-819.

4. FOR IMPORTS OF CERTAIN ALUMINUM PLATE FROM SOUTH AFRICA, CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION SHALL SUSPEND LIQUIDATION OF SUCH SHIPMENTS ENTERED OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION

OR AFTER MAY 21, 2004, EFFECTIVE MAY 21, 2004, CBP SHALL REQUIRE, FOR SUCH ENTRIES, A CASH DEPOSIT OR THE POSTING OF A BOND EQUAL TO THE MARGINS SHOWN BELOW:
