RE: REVOCATION OF ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER IN PART ON COLOR TELEVISION RECEIVERS, EXCEPT FOR VIDEO MONITORS, FROM TAIWAN (A583009).

1. THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE HAS REVOKED THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER ON COLOR TELEVISION RECEIVERS, EXCEPT FOR VIDEO MONITORS, FROM TAIWAN IN PART AND PUBLISHED THE REVOCATION IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER ON 11/09/1990. THE PARTIAL REVOCATION APPLIES TO ALL SUBJECT MERCHANDISE MANUFACTURED AND EXPORTED BY CAPETRONIC AND

THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE REVOCATION IS 05/29/1987.

2. THEREFORE, CBP IS DIRECTED TO TERMINATE THE SUSPENSION OF

LIQUIDATION FOR ALL SHIPMENTS OF COLOR TELEVISION RECEIVERS, EXCEPT FOR VIDEO MONITORS, MANUFACTURED AND EXPORTED BY CAPETRONIC ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION

ON OR AFTER 05/29/1987. ALL ENTRIES OF THE SUBJECT PRODUCT MANUFACTURED AND EXPORTED BY CAPETRONIC THAT WERE SUSPENDED ON OR  
OR  
AFTER 05/29/1987 SHOULD BE LIQUIDATED WITHOUT REGARD TO ANTIDUMPING DUTIES (I.E., RELEASE ALL BONDS AND REFUND ALL CASH DEPOSITS).

3. NOTE THAT THE ORDER WAS REVOKED IN ITS ENTIRETY, EFFECTIVE 01/01/2000, AS A RESULT OF A FIVE-YEAR ("SUNSET") REVIEW (SEE MESSAGE NUMBER 0021208, DATED 01/21/2000).

4. THE ASSESSMENT OF ANTIDUMPING DUTIES BY CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION ON ENTRIES OF THIS MERCHANDISE IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930. SECTION 778 REQUIRES THAT CBP PAYS INTEREST ON OVERPAYMENTS AND ASSESS INTEREST ON UNDERPAYMENTS OF THE REQUIRED AMOUNTS DEPOSITED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES. THE INTEREST PROVISIONS ARE NOT APPLICABLE TO CASH OR BONDS POSTED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES BEFORE THE DATE OF PUBLICATION OF THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER. INTEREST SHALL BE CALCULATED FROM THE DATE OF PAYMENT OF ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES THROUGH THE DATE OF LIQUIDATION. THE RATE AT WHICH SUCH INTEREST IS PAYABLE IS THE RATE IN EFFECT UNDER SECTION 6621 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1954 FOR SUCH PERIOD.
