RE: ANTIDUMPING SCOPE RULING ON WOODEN BEDROOM FURNITURE
FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA A-570-890

1. ON AUGUST 31, 2004, IN RESPONSE TO A REQUEST BY IMPORTERS' COALITION , THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE ISSUED A SCOPE RULING THAT JEWELRY ARMOIRES AND CHEVAL MIRRORS ARE NOT WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION COVERING WOODEN BEDROOM FURNITURE FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA (A-570-890).

2. THE COMMERCE DEPARTMENT DETERMINED THAT JEWELRY ARMOIRES AND

CHEVAL MIRRORS SHOULD BE EXCLUDED FROM THE SCOPE OF THIS INVESTIGATION BECAUSE THE PETITIONERS AGREE THAT THESE ITEMS WERE NOT INTENDED TO BE INCLUDED WITHIN THE SCOPE. THEREFORE, JEWELRY ARMOIRES AND CHEVAL MIRRORS ARE NOT WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION COVERING WOODEN BEDROOM FURNITURE FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA.

3. CHEVAL MIRRORS ARE DEFINED AS ANY FRAMED, TILTABLE MIRROR WITH A HEIGHT IN EXCESS OF 50 INCHES THAT IS MOUNTED ON A FLOOR-STANDING, HINGED BASE. JEWELRY ARMOIRES ARE DEFINED AS ANY ARMOIRE, CABINET, OR OTHER ACCENT ITEM FOR THE PURPOSE OF STORING JEWELRY, NOT TO EXCEED 24 INCHES IN WIDTH, 18 INCHES IN DEPTH, AND 49 INCHES IN HEIGHT, INCLUDING A MINIMUM OF 5 LINED DRAWERS LINED WITH FELT OR FELT-LIKE MATERIAL, AT LEAST ONE SIDE DOOR LINED WITH FELT OR FELT-LIKE MATERIAL, WITH NECKLACE HANGERS, AND A FLIP-TOP LID WITH INSET MIRROR.

4. EFFECTIVE AUGUST 31, 2004, U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION (CBP) OFFICERS SHOULD TERMINATE SUSPENSION AND LIQUIDATE ALL UNLIQUIDATED ENTRIES, REGARDLESS OF ENTRY DATE, OF JEWELRY ARMOIRES AND CHEVAL MIRRORS DESCRIBED ABOVE.

5. REFUND ANY CASH DEPOSITS WITH INTEREST AND RELEASE ANY BONDS RELATING TO THE JEWELRY ARMOIRES AND CHEVAL MIRRORS DESCRIBED ABOVE.

6. THE ASSESSMENT OF ANTIDUMPING DUTIES BY CBP ON ENTRIES OF THIS MERCHANDISE IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930. SECTION 778 REQUIRES THAT CBP PAY INTEREST ON OVERPAYMENTS, OR ASSESS INTEREST ON UNDER PAYMENTS, OF THE REQUIRED AMOUNTS DEPOSITED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES. THE INTEREST PROVISIONS ARE NOT APPLICABLE TO CASH OR BONDS POSTED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES BEFORE THE DATE OF PUBLICATION OF THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER. INTEREST SHALL BE CALCULATED FROM THE DATE PAYMENT OF ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES IS REQUIRED THROUGH THE DATE OF LIQUIDATION. THE RATE AT WHICH SUCH INTEREST

IS PAYABLE IS THE RATE IN EFFECT UNDER SECTION 6621 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1954 FOR SUCH PERIOD.

7. CONTINUE TO SUSPEND LIQUIDATION OF ENTRIES OF ALL OTHER WOODEN BEDROOM FURNITURE COVERED BY THE SCOPE OF THIS INVESTIGATION.
