RE: REVOCATION OF ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER, IN PART, ON CORROSION-RESISTANT CARBON STEEL FLAT PRODUCTS FROM KOREA (A-580-816).

1. COMMERCE HAS REVOKED THE ANTIDUMPING ORDER ON CORROSION-RESISTANT CARBON STEEL FLAT PRODUCTS (CORE) FROM KOREA IN PART AND PUBLISHED THE REVOCATION IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER ON 03/12/2012. THE PARTIAL REVOCATION APPLIES TO ALL SUBJECT MERCHANDISE MANUFACTURED AND EXPORTED BY POHANG IRON AND STEEL COMPANY, LTD. (POSCO) (A-580-816-001) OR MANUFACTURED AND EXPORTED BY POHANG COATED STEEL CO., LTD. (POCOS) (A-580-816-007); THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE REVOCATION IS 08/01/2010.

2. THEREFORE, CBP IS DIRECTED TO TERMINATE THE SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION FOR ALL SHIPMENTS OF CORE FROM KOREA WHICH WERE MANUFACTURED AND EXPORTED BY POSCO AND POCOS AND ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER 08/01/2010. ALL ENTRIES OF CORE FROM KOREA WHICH WERE MANUFACTURED AND EXPORTED BY POSCO AND POCOS, AND SUSPENDED ON OR AFTER 08/01/2010 SHOULD BE LIQUIDATED WITHOUT REGARD TO ANTIDUMPING DUTIES (I.E., RELEASE ALL BONDS AND REFUND ALL CASH DEPOSITS).

3. NOTICE OF THE LIFTING OF SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION OF ENTRIES COVERED BY PARAGRAPH 2 WHICH WERE ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER 08/01/2010 OCCURRED WITH THE PUBLICATION OF THE NOTICE OF REVOCATION IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER (77 FR 14501, 03/12/2012).

4. THE ASSESSMENT OF ANTIDUMPING DUTIES BY CBP ON SHIPMENTS OR ENTRIES OF THIS MERCHANDISE IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930, AS AMENDED. SECTION 778 REQUIRES THAT CBP PAY INTEREST ON OVERPAYMENTS OR ASSESS INTEREST ON UNDERPAYMENTS OF THE REQUIRED AMOUNTS DEPOSITED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES. THE INTEREST PROVISIONS ARE NOT APPLICABLE TO CASH OR BONDS POSTED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES BEFORE THE DATE OF PUBLICATION OF THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY

ORDER. INTEREST SHALL BE CALCULATED FROM THE DATE PAYMENT OF ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES IS REQUIRED THROUGH THE DATE OF LIQUIDATION. THE RATE AT WHICH SUCH INTEREST IS PAYABLE IS THE RATE IN EFFECT UNDER SECTION 6621 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1954 FOR SUCH PERIOD.
