RE: Temporary restraining order and preliminary injunction on Certain Polyester Staple Fiber from China for Zhaoqing Tifo New Fiber Co., Ltd. for the period 6/1/10-5/31/11 (A-570-905), court no. 13-00044

1. On 01/31/2013, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued both a temporary restraining order and a preliminary injunction enjoining liquidation of certain entries which are subject to the antidumping duty order on Certain Polyester Staple Fiber from the People's Republic of China (A-570-905) for the period 06/01/2010 through 05/31/2011.
2. The temporary restraining order and the preliminary injunction were issued in connection with court case number 13-00044 and enjoin liquidation of the entries described in paragraph 3 below.
3. Accordingly, until further notice, do not liquidate entries of subject merchandise which were exported from the People's Republic of China to the United States by Zhaoqing Tifo New Fiber Co., Ltd., and which were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after June 1, 2010 through May 31, 2011. Any entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by the injunction have not yet been issued.
5. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to prevent liquidation of any entries subject to the above.
6. Commerce's APO Docket Center was served with the above-referenced temporary restraining order and preliminary injunction on 01/31/2013. Pursuant to the terms of the temporary restraining order, no liquidation of the entries covered by the temporary restraining order may be made for entries which remain unliquidated as of the date of the temporary restraining order until 5 o'clock p.m. on the fifth business day after which copies of the preliminary injunction are personally served on Commerce's APO Docket Center. Pursuant to the terms of the preliminary injunction, no liquidation of the entries covered by the preliminary injunction may be made for entries which remain unliquidated as of 5:00 p.m. on the fifth business day after which copies of the preliminary injunction are personally served on Commerce's APO Docket Center.
