RE: Revocation of countervailing duty order on honey from Argentina (C-351-813)

1. As a result of a notification from the petitioners, the American Honey Producers' Association and the Sioux Honey Association, that they are no longer interested in the countervailing duty order on honey from Argentina, Commerce has revoked the order effective 12/01/2011 and published the revocation in the Federal Register on 12/31/2012 (77 FR 77029).
2. Therefore, CBP is directed to terminate the suspension of liquidation for all shipments of honey from Argentina which were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 12/01/2011. All entries of the subject merchandise that were suspended on or after 12/01/2011 through 12/31/2011 should be liquidated in accordance with message 2121304 dated 04/30/2012. All entries of the subject merchandise that were suspended on or after 01/01/2012 should be liquidated without regard to countervailing duties (i.e., release all bonds and refund all cash deposits).
3. Notice of the lifting of suspension of liquidation of entries of subject merchandise which are covered by paragraph 2 and entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 12/01/2011 through 12/31/2011 occurred with the publication of the notice of rescission of administrative review of the countervailing duty order on honey from Argentina in the Federal Register (77 FR 21968, 04/12/2012). Notice of the lifting of suspension of liquidation of entries of subject merchandise which are covered by paragraph 2 and entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 01/01/2012 occurred with the publication of the notice of revocation in the Federal Register (77 FR 77029, 12/31/2012).
4. Note that this countervailing duty order was originally revoked effective 08/02/2012 (see message number 2285308, dated 10/11/2012). That revocation message is still in effect. This new message is pursuant to a distinct determination (i.e., no interest changed circumstances review) that established an earlier effective date of revocation (i.e., 12/01/2011; see paragraph one above).
5. The assessment of countervailing duties by CBP on shipments or entries of this merchandise is subject to the provisions of section 778 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended. Section 778

requires that CBP pay interest on overpayments or assess interest on underpayments of the required amounts deposited as estimated countervailing duties. The interest provisions are not applicable to cash or bonds posted as estimated countervailing duties before the date of publication of the countervailing duty order. Interest shall be calculated from the date payment of estimated countervailing duties is required through the date of liquidation. The rate at which such interest is payable is the rate in effect under section 6621 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 for such period.
