RE: Scope determination on antidumping duty (AD) order on aluminum extrusions from the People's Republic of China (PRC) A-570-967.

1. On 11/30/2012, in response to a request by Northern California Glass Management Association the Department of Commerce (Commerce) issued a final scope determination that curtain wall units and other parts and components of curtain walls are within the scope of the AD duty order on aluminum extrusions from the PRC (A-570-967).
2. Because the language of the scope of the order specifically provides that subject aluminum extrusions may be described at the time of importation as parts for final products [including curtain walls] that are assembled after importation, Commerce found that curtain wall units and other parts and components of curtain wall systems are within the scope of the order. Curtain wall parts and components fall short of the final finished curtain wall that envelops an entire building, but they may be assembled into modules that are designed to be interlocked with other curtain wall parts. Further, as provided in the language of the scope of the order, the scope does not include the non-aluminum extrusion components.
3. Continue to suspend liquidation of entries of aluminum extrusions from the PRC, including curtain wall units and other parts and components of curtain walls, subject to the AD order on aluminum extrusions from the PRC.
