RE: Termination of the countervailing duty investigation of circular welded carbon-quality steel pipe from the United Arab Emirates (C-520-806)

1. On 12/11/2012, the International Trade Commission (ITC) published in the Federal Register its negative final determination in the countervailing duty investigation of circular welded carbon-quality steel pipe from the United Arab Emirates (C-520-806) (77 FR 73674). The countervailing duty investigation of circular welded carbon-quality steel pipe from the United Arab Emirates has been terminated.

2. This instruction replaces message number 2346301 which was inactivated on 12/12/2012.

3. CBP should discontinue the suspension of liquidation of entries of merchandise which were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 10/22/2012. Entries should be liquidated without regard for countervailing duties. All estimated countervailing duties deposited on entries of the subject merchandise shall be refunded and bonds or other security released at the time of liquidation.

4. Notice of the lifting of suspension of liquidation of entries of merchandise entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 10/22/2012 occurred with the publication of the ITC's notice of negative final determination of investigation (77 FR 73674, 12/11/2012).

5. The interest provisions of section 778 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, do not apply.
