1. IN MESSAGE 5210212 DATED 07/29/2005, WE INSTRUCTED U.S.
CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION (CBP) THAT ON 07/27/2005 THE U.S.
COURT OF INTERNATIONAL TRADE (CIT) ISSUED A TEMPORARY RESTRAINING
ORDER (TRO) ENJOINING CBP FROM: (A) IMPLEMENTING LIQUIDATION
INSTRUCTIONS ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE IN CONJUNCTION
WITH MESSAGE NUMBERS 5182203 DATED 07/01/2005, 5189205 DATED
07/08/2005, 5189204 DATED 07/08/2005, AND 5199201 DATED
07/18/2005 OR; (B) OTHERWISE TAKING ANY ACTION THAT RESULTS IN
THE TREATMENT OF ENTRIES OF STAINLESS STEEL PLATE IN COILS (SSPC)

HOT ROLLED IN GERMANY AND NOT FURTHER COLD ROLLED IN BELGIUM AS HAVING THE COUNTRY OF ORIGIN OF BELGIUM FOR THE PURPOSES OF ASSESSING ANTIDUMPING OR COUNTERVAILING DUTIES. IT WAS FURTHER ORDERED THAT THE TRO SHOULD APPLY TO CERTAIN ENTRIES, WHICH REMAINED UNLIQUIDATED OR UNDER PROTEST. SEE MESSAGE NUMBER 5210212 DATED 07/29/2005 FOR THE COMPLETE LIST. THE TRO EXPIRED ON 08/17/2005.

2. ON 8/17/2005 IN SLIP OPINION 05-97 THE CIT EXTENDED THE TRO UNTIL CLOSE OF BUSINESS 08/24/2005. ACCORDINGLY, DO NOT: (A) IMPLEMENT LIQUIDATION INSTRUCTIONS ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE IN CONJUNCTION WITH MESSAGE NUMBERS 5182203 DATED 07/01/2005, 5189205 DATED 07/08/2005, 5189204 DATED 07/08/2005, AND 5199201 DATED 07/18/2005 OR; (B) OTHERWISE TAKE ANY ACTION THAT RESULTS IN THE TREATMENT OF ENTRIES OF STAINLESS STEEL PLATE IN COILS (SSPC) HOT ROLLED IN GERMANY AND NOT FURTHER COLD ROLLED IN BELGIUM AS HAVING THE COUNTRY OF ORIGIN OF BELGIUM FOR THE PURPOSES OF ASSESSING ANTIDUMPING OR COUNTERVAILING DUTIES. IT WAS FURTHER ORDERED THAT THE TRO SHOULD APPLY TO CERTAIN ENTRIES, WHICH REMAINED UNLIQUIDATED OR UNDER PROTEST. SEE MESSAGE NUMBER 5210212 DATED 07/29/2005 FOR THE COMPLETE LIST.
