RE: REVOCATION OF COUNTERVAILING DUTY ORDER ON SUGAR FROM THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY: BELGIUM(C-423-046), DENMARK (C-409-046),FRANCE(C-427-046),UNITED KINGDOM(C-412-046)

1. FOR CBP PURPOSE, THIS ORDER IS IDENTIFIED AS, SUGAR FROM BELGIUM (C-423-046), DENMARK (C-409-046), FRANCE (C-427-046) AND UNITED KINGDOM (C-412-046).
2. AS A RESULT OF A FIVE-YEAR ("SUNSET") REVIEW, THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE HAS REVOKED THE COUNTERVAILING DUTY ORDER ON SUGAR

FROM THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY (C-408-046), AND PUBLISHED THE

REVOCAION IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER (70 FR 54522) ON SEPTEMBER 15, 2005. THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE REVOCATION IS OCTOBER 28, 2004. SUGAR FROM THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY IS CURRENTLY CLASSIFIED IN THE FOLLOWING HARMONIZED TARIFF SCHEDULE OF THE UNITED STATES ("HTSUS") ITEM NUMBERS: 1701.11.05, 1701.11.10, 1701.11.20, 1701.11.50, 1701.12.05, 1701.12.10, 1701.12.50, 1701.91.05, 1701.91.10, 1701.91.30, 1701.99.05, 1701.99.1090, 1701.99.5090, 1702.90.05, 1702.90.10, 1702.90.20, 2106.90.42, 2106.90.44, 2106.90.46.

3. CUSTOMS IS DIRECTED TO TERMINATE THE SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION FOR ALL SHIPMENTS OF SUGAR FROM THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY. ALL ENTRIES OF THE SUBJECT MERCHANDISE SUSPENDED ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 28, 2004, SHOULD BE LIQUIDATED WITHOUT REGARD TO COUNTERVAILING DUTIES (I.E., RELEASE ALL BONDS AND REFUND ALL CASH DEPOSITS, WITH INTEREST). INTEREST SHALL BE CALCULATED FROM THE DATE PAYMENT OF ESTIMATED COUNTERVAILING DUTIES IS REQUIRED THROUGH THE DATE OF LIQUIDATION. THE RATE AT WHICH SUCH INTEREST IS PAYABLE IS THE RATE IN EFFECT UNDER SECTION 6621 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1954 FOR SUCH PERIOD.

4. ALL SUSPENDED ENTRIES OF THE SUBJECT PRODUCT ENTERED OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE PRIOR TO OCTOBER 28, 2004, SHOULD NOT, REPEAT NOT, BE LIQUIDATED UNTIL YOU RECEIVE SEPARATE AND SPECIFIC LIQUIDATION INSTRUCTIONS.

5. THE ASSOCIATED ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDERS ON SUGAR FROM BELGIUM, FRANCE AND GERMANY WERE ALSO REVOKED EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 28, 2004. LIQUIDATION INSTRUCTIONS ARE BEING SENT SEPARATELY.
