RE: Antidumping duty scope determination on circular welded non-alloy steel pipe from Mexico (A-201-805)

Notice of the lifting of suspension occurred on the message date of these instructions. See paragraph 5 below.

1. Commerce received a scope ruling request from LDA Incorporado. Commerce issued a final scope determination on 11/15/2012 that finished electrical rigid metal conduit produced by PYTCO, S.A. de C.V., which LDA Incorporado imports is not within the scope of the antidumping duty order on circular welded non-alloy steel pipe from Mexico.
2. Commerce determined that LDA Incorporado's finished electrical rigid metal conduit produced by PYTCO, S.A. de C.V., is outside the scope of the order because: it has various outside diameters ranging from 1/2 inch to 4 inches; is in ten foot lengths; is galvanized through a hot-dipped process; is internally and externally coated with zinc; complies with standard UL-6 for "electrical rigid ferrous metal conduit" and ANSI standard C80.1 for "electrical rigid steel conduit;" is marked with the name of the manufacturer, PYTCO; identifies Mexico as the country of origin; and displays the UL trademark identifying the conduit as a UL-listed "electrical rigid metal conduit." LDA Incorporado's finished electrical rigid metal conduit produced by PYTCO, S.A. de C.V., meets the definition of the exception for "finished conduit" as specified in the scope of the order. Therefore, LDA Incorporado's finished electrical rigid metal conduit produced by PYTCO, S.A. de C.V., is not within the scope of the antidumping duty order on circular welded non-alloy steel pipe from Mexico.
3. For all entries of LDA Incorporado's finished electrical rigid metal conduit produced by PYTCO, S.A. de C.V., not within scope that remain unliquidated on or after 04/28/1992, CBP shall terminate suspension and liquidate entries of product not within scope which were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption.
4. Refund any cash deposits and release any bonds relating to LDA Incorporado's finished electrical rigid metal conduit produced by PYTCO, S.A. de C.V., described above.

5. These instructions constitute notice of the lifting of suspension of liquidation of entries of LDA Incorporado's finished electrical rigid metal conduit produced by PYTCO, S.A. de C.V., entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 04/28/1992.
  
6. The assessment of antidumping duties by CBP on shipments or entries of this merchandise is subject to the provisions of section 778 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended. Section 778 requires that CBP pay interest on overpayments or assess interest on underpayments of the required amounts deposited as estimated antidumping duties. The interest provisions are not applicable to cash or bonds posted as estimated antidumping duties before the date of publication of the antidumping duty order. Interest shall be calculated from the date payment of estimated antidumping duties is required through the date of liquidation. The rate at which such interest is payable is the rate in effect under section 6621 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 for such period.
  
7. Unless instructed otherwise, for all other shipments of circular welded non-alloy steel pipe from Mexico not covered by paragraph 2 above, you shall continue to collect cash deposits of estimated antidumping duties for the merchandise at the current rates.
