1. ON 04/04/2006, THE U.S. COURT OF INTERNATIONAL TRADE ISSUED A
PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION ENJOINING LIQUIDATION OF CERTAIN ENTRIES
THAT ARE SUBJECT TO THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER ON OIL COUNTRY
TUBULAR GOODS (OCTG) FROM KOREA (COMMERCE CASE # A-580-825 /
CUSTOMS CASE # A-580-215), MANUFACTURED AND EXPORTED BY HUSTEEL
CO., LTD. (HUSTEEL) OR SEAH STEEL CORPORATION, LTD. (SEAH) FOR
THE PERIOD 08/01/2003 THROUGH 07/31/2004.

2. THIS INJUNCTION WAS ISSUED IN CONNECTION WITH COURT CASE NUMBER 06-75 AND ENJOINS LIQUIDATION OF THE ENTRIES DESCRIBED ABOVE.

3. ACCORDINGLY, UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE, DO NOT LIQUIDATE ENTRIES OF SUBJECT MERCHANDISE THAT WERE PRODUCED AND EXPORTED BY HUSTEEL OR SEAH AND THAT WERE ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION DURING THE PERIOD 08/01/2003 THROUGH 07/31/2004. CONTINUE TO SUSPEND LIQUIDATION OF THESE ENTRIES UNTIL LIQUIDATION INSTRUCTIONS ARE PROVIDED.

4. THIS INJUNCTION APPLIES TO THE LIQUIDATION INSTRUCTIONS COVERED BY MESSAGE NUMBERS 6083202 AND 6083201, DATED 03/24/2006.

5. EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION (CBP) IS INSTRUCTED TO PREVENT LIQUIDATION OF ANY ENTRIES SUBJECT TO THE ABOVE.

6. THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE WAS SERVED WITH THE ABOVE REFERENCED INJUNCTION ON 04/05/2006. PURSUANT TO THE TERMS OF THE INJUNCTION, NO LIQUIDATION OF THE ENTRIES COVERED BY THE INJUNCTION MAY BE MADE FOR ENTRIES WHICH REMAIN UNLIQUIDATED AS OF 04/12/2006.
