1. ON JUNE 13, 2006, THE U.S. COURT OF INTERNATIONAL TRADE  
ISSUED A PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION ENJOINING LIQUIDATION OF CERTAIN  
ENTRIES WHICH ARE SUBJECT TO THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER ON  
AUTOMOTIVE REPLACEMENT GLASS WINDSHIELDS FROM THE PEOPLE'S  
REPUBLIC OF CHINA (A-570-867), MANUFACTURED/EXPORTED FROM THE  
PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA TO THE UNITED STATES BY CHANGCHUN  
PILKINGTON SAFETY GLASS, CO., LTD., GUILIN PILKINGTON SAFETY  
GLASS CO., LTD. AND WUHAN YAOHUA PILKINGTON SAFETY GLASS CO.,

LTD., ON OR AFTER APRIL 1, 2005. THIS IS AN OPEN ENDED INJUNCTION.

2. THIS INJUNCTION WAS ISSUED IN CONNECTION WITH COURT CASE NUMBER 02-00282 AND ENJOINS LIQUIDATION OF THE ENTRIES DESCRIBED ABOVE.

3. ACCORDINGLY, UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE, DO NOT LIQUIDATE ENTRIES OF SUBJECT MERCHANDISE WHICH WERE MANUFACTURED/EXPORTED BY CHANGCHUN PILKINGTON SAFETY GLASS, CO., LTD., GUILIN PILKINGTON SAFETY GLASS CO., LTD. OR WUHAN YAOHUA PILKINGTON SAFETY GLASS CO., LTD., AND WHICH WERE ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER APRIL 1, 2005. CONTINUE TO SUSPEND LIQUIDATION OF THESE ENTRIES UNTIL LIQUIDATION INSTRUCTIONS ARE PROVIDED.

4. LIQUIDATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENTRIES AFFECTED BY THIS INJUNCTION HAVE NOT YET BEEN ISSUED.

5. THESE INSTRUCTIONS TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

6. THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE WAS SERVED WITH THE ABOVE REFERENCED INJUNCTION ON JUNE 14, 2006. PURSUANT TO THE TERMS OF THE INJUNCTION, NO LIQUIDATION OF THE ENTRIES COVERED BY THE INJUNCTION MAY BE MADE FOR ENTRIES WHICH REMAIN UNLIQUIDATED AS OF THE FIFTH BUSINESS DAY AFTER THE DAY ON WHICH COPIES OF THE ORDER WERE SERVED ON THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE.
