RE: LIQUIDATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR MERCHANDISE SUBJECT TO CVD ORDER ON NEW ZEALAND STEEL WIRE (C614-601) & VENEZUELAN CIRCULAR WELDED NON-ALLOY STEEL PIPE (C-307-806)

1. THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE DID NOT RECEIVE A REQUEST FOR AN ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW OF THE COUNTERVAILING DUTY ORDER ON STEEL WIRE FROM NEW ZEALAND (C-614-601) FOR THE JULY 1, 1994 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 1994 REVIEW PERIOD OR FOR VENEZUELAN CIRCULAR WELDED NON-ALLOY STEEL PIPE (C-307-806) FOR THE JANUARY 1, 1994 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 1994 REVIEW PERIOD. ON AUGUST 9, 1995, BOTH THESE COUNTERVAILING DUTY ORDERS WERE REVOKED FOR ALL ENTRIES MADE ON OR

AFTER JANUARY 1, 1995.

2. THE COUNTERVAILING DUTY ORDER ON STEEL WIRE FROM NEW ZEALAND (C-614-601) COVERED SHIPMENTS FROM NEW ZEALAND OF GALVANIZED CARBON STEEL WIRE, WHICH IS A ROUND CARBON STEEL WIRE COATED OR PLATE

D WITH ZINC AND 0.06 INCH OR MORE IN DIAMETER. SUCH MERCHANDISE IS CLASSIFIABLE UNDER HARMONIZED TARIFF SCHEDULE (HTS) ITEM NUMBERS 7217.12.50, 7217.22.10 AND 7217.32.10.

CIRCULAR WELDED NON-ALLOY STEEL PIPE (C-307-806) COVERED SHIPMENTS FROM VENEZUELA OF CIRCULAR WELDED NON-ALLOY STEEL PIPES AND TUBES, OF CIRCULAR CROSS-SECTION, NOT MORE THAN 406.4MM (16 INCHES) IN OUTSIDE DIAMETER, REGARDLESS OF WALL THICKNESS, SURFACE FINISH (BLACK, GALVANIZED, OR PAINTED), OR END FINISH (PLAIN END, BEVELLED END, THREADED, OR THREADED AND COUPLED). THESE PIPES AND TUBE

S ARE GENERALLY KNOWN AS STANDARD PIPE, THROUGH THEY MAY ALSO BE CALLED STRUCTURAL OR MECHANICAL TUBING IN CERTAIN APPLICATIONS. STANDARD PIPES AND TUBES ARE INTENDED FOR THE LOW PRESSURE CONVEYANCE OF WATER, STEAM, NATURAL GAS, AIR AND OTHER LIQUIDS AND GASES IN PLUMBING AND HEATING SYSTEMS, AIR CONDITIONING UNITS, AUTOMATIC SPRINKLER SYSTEMS, AND OTHER RELATED USES. STANDARD PIPE

MAY ALSO BE USED FOR LIGHT-LOAD BEARING AND MECHANICAL APPLICATIONS,

SUCH AS FOR FENCE TUBING, AND FOR PROTECTION OF ELECTRICAL WIRING, SUCH AS CONDUIT SHELLS. THE SCOPE IS NOT LIMITED TO STANDARD PIPE AND FENCE TUBING, OR THOSE TYPES OF MECHANICAL AND STRUCTURAL PIPE THAT ARE USED IN STANDARD PIPE APPLICATIONS. ALL CARBON STEEL PIPES AND TUBES WITHIN THE PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OUTLINED ABOVE ARE INCLUDED WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THIS ORDER, EXCEPT LINE PIPE, OIL COUNTRY TUBULAR GOODS, BOILER TUBING, COLD-DRAWN OR COLD-ROLLED

MECHANICAL TUBING, PIPE AND TUBE HOLLOWES AND REDRAWS, FINISHED SCAFFOLDING, AND FINISHED RIGID CONDUIT. STANDARD PIPE THAT IS DUAL OR TRIPLE CERTIFIED/STENCILED THAT ENTERS THE U.S. AS LINE PIPE OF A KIND USED FOR OIL OR GAS PIPESLINES IS ALSO NOT INCLUDED

IN THIS ORDER. IMPORTS OF THESE PRODUCTS ARE CURRENTLY CLASSIFIABLE UNDER THE FOLLOWING HTS SUBHEADINGS; 7306.30.10.00, 7306.30.50.25, 7306.30.50.32, 7306.30.50.40, 7306.30.50.55, 7306.30.50.85, AND 7306.30.50.90.

3. THEREFORE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 355.22(G) OF THE COMMERCE REGULATIONS, YOU ARE TO ASSESS COUNTERVAILING DUTIES AT RATES

EQUAL TO THE CASH DEPOSIT OF ESTIMATED COUNTERVAILING DUTIES REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF ENTRY SUMMARY ON NEW ZEALAND STEEL WIRE EXPORTED ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 1994 WHICH ENTERED ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 1994 AND FOR VENEZUELAN CIRCULAR WELDED NON-ALLOY STEEL PIPE EXPORTED ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1994 WHICH ENTERED ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 1994.

4. THE RATES OF ESTIMATED COUNTERVAILING DUTIES WHICH WERE REQUIRED TO BE DEPOSITED ARE:

5. THE SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION ORDERED FOR STEEL WIRE FROM NEWZEALAND EXPORTED ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 1994 WHICH ENTERED ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 1994 IS LIFTED. THE SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION ORDERED FOR CIRCULAR WELDED NON-ALLOY STEEL PIPE FROM VENEZUELA EXPORTED ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1994 WHICH ENTERED ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 1994 IS LIFTED. LIQUIDATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR BOTH OF THESE COUNTERVAILING DUTY ORDERS FOR ENTRIES MADE ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1995 WERE ISSUED IN E-MAIL MESSAGES #5229116 AND #5229118 DATED MARCH 17, 1995. THE SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION FOR ALL SHIPMENTS OF THE MERCHANDISE WAS TERMINATED ON AUGUST 9, 1995.

6. THE ASSESSMENT OF COUNTERVAILING DUTIES BY THE CUSTOMS SERVICE ON ENTRIES OF THIS MERCHANDISE IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930. SECTION 778 REQUIRES THAT CUSTOMS PAY INTEREST ON OVERPAYMENTS, OR ASSESS INTEREST ON UNDER PAYMENTS, OF THE REQUIRED AMOUNTS DEPOSITED AS COUNTERVAILING DUTIES. THE INTEREST PROVISIONS ARE NOT APPLICABLE TO CASH OR BONDS POSTED AS ESTIMATED COUNTERVAILING DUTIES BEFORE THE DATE OF PUBLICATION OF THE COUNTERVAILING DUTY ORDER. INTEREST SHALL BE CALCULATED FROM THE DATE THAT PAYMENT OF ESTIMATED COUNTERVAILING DUTIES IS REQUIRED THROUGH THE DATE OF LIQUIDATION. THE RATE AT WHICH SUCH INTEREST IS PAYABLE IS THE RATE IN EFFECT UNDER SECTION 6621 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1954 FOR SUCH PERIOD.
