RE: Preliminary injunction on certain activated carbon from China for the period 04/01/2010 through 03/31/2011 for Carbon Activated Corporation and Car Go Worldwide, Inc.(A-570-904), court number 12-00396

1. On 12/3/2012, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction enjoining liquidation of certain entries which are subject to the antidumping duty order on certain activated carbon from the People's Republic of China (A-570-904) for the period 04/01/2010 through 03/31/2011.

2. This injunction was issued in connection with court case number 12-00396 and enjoins liquidation of the entries described in paragraph 3 below.

3. Accordingly, until further notice, do not liquidate entries of subject merchandise which were exported by Ningxia Mineral and Chemical Limited; Shanxi DMD Corporation; Shanxi Sincere Industrial Co., Ltd.; Shanxi Industry Technology Trading Co., Ltd.; Tangshan Solid Carbon Co., Ltd.; and Tianjin Maijin Industries Co., Ltd., imported by or sold to (as indicated on the commercial invoice or Customs documentation) the importers or customers listed below, and which were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption during the period 04/01/2010 through 03/31/2011. Any entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.

Importer: Carbon Activated Corporation

Importer: Car Go Worldwide, Inc. (a.k.a. Cargo Worldwide, Inc.)

4. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by the injunction have not yet been issued.

5. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to prevent liquidation of any entries subject to the above.

6. Commerce's APO Docket Center was served with the above-referenced injunction on 12/3/2012. Pursuant to the terms of the injunction, no liquidation of the entries covered by the

injunction may be made for entries which remain unliquidated as of 5:00 p.m. EST on the fifth business day after which copies of this order are personally served on Commerce's APO Docket Center.
