1. ON JANUARY 17, 1997, THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE PUBLISHED IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER, NOTICE OF ITS FINAL DETERMINATION OF SALES AT LESS THAN FAIR VALUE IN THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION OF BERYLLIUM METAL AND HIGH BERYLLIUM ALLOYS FROM KAZAKSTAN (A-463-405).

2. THE SCOPE OF THIS INVESTIGATION IS BERYLLIUM METAL AND HIGH BERYLLIUM ALLOYS WITH A BERYLLIUM CONTENT EQUAL TO OR GREATER THAN 30 PERCENT BY WEIGHT, WHETHER IN INGOT, BILLET, POWDER,

BLOCK, LUMP, CHUNK, BLANK, OR OTHER SEMIFINISHED FORM. THESE ARE INTERMEDIATE OR SEMIFINISHED PRODUCTS THAT REQUIRE FURTHER MACHINING, CASTING, AND/OR FABRICATING INTO SHEET, EXTRUSIONS, FORGINGS OR OTHER SHAPES IN ORDER TO MEET THE SPECIFICATIONS OF THE END USER. BERYLLIUM AND HIGH BERYLLIUM ALLOYS WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THIS INVESTIGATION ARE CLASSIFIABLE UNDER THE HARMONIZED TARIFF SCHEDULE OF THE UNITED STATES (HTSUS) 8112.11.6000, 8112.11.3000, 7601.20.9075, AND 7601.20.9090. ALTHOUGH THE HTSUS SUBHEADINGS ARE PROVIDED FOR CONVENIENCE AND CUSTOMS PURPOSES,

OUR WRITTEN DESCRIPTION OF THE SCOPE OF THIS INVESTIGATION IS DISPOSITIVE.

3. FOR FURTHER REPORTING PURPOSES, THIS CASE HAS BEEN ASSIGNED INVESTIGATION NUMBER A-834-805. FOR CUSTOMS PURPOSES ONLY, THE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER IS A-463-405.

4. FOR IMPORTS OF BERYLLIUM AND HIGH BERYLLIUM ALLOYS FROM THE REPUBLIC OF KAZAKSTAN, THE CUSTOMS SERVICE SHALL SUSPEND LIQUIDATION OF SUCH SHIPMENTS THAT ARE ENTERED OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER JANUARY 17, 1997. CUSTOMS SHALL REQUIRE FOR ENTRY SUMMARIES A CASH DEPOSIT OR THE POSTING OF A BOND EQUAL TO THE MARGINS SHOWN BELOW.
