RE: TERMINATION OF SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION OF BERYLLIUM METALS AND HIGH BERYLLIUM ALLOYS FROM THE REPUBLIC OF KAZAKSTAN (A-463-405)

1. ON FEBRUARY 27, 1997, THE INTERNATIONAL TRADE COMMISSION (ITC) NOTIFIED THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE OF ITS TERMINATION OF THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION OF BERYLLIUM METAL AND HIGH BERYLLIUM ALLOYS FROM KAZAKSTAN. THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION OF BERYLLIUM METAL AND HIGH BERYLLIUM ALLOYS FROM THE REPUBLIC OF KAZAKSTAN HAS BEEN TERMINATED.

2. THE SCOPE OF THIS INVESTIGATION IS BERYLLIUM METAL AND HIGH BERYLLIUM ALLOYS WITH A BERYLLIUM CONTENT EQUAL TO OR GREATER

THAN 30 PERCENT BY WEIGHT, WHETHER IN INGOT, BILLET, POWDER, BLOCK, LUMP, CHUNK, BLANK, OR OTHER SEMIFINISHED FORM. THESE ARE INTERMEDIATE OR SEMIFINISHED PRODUCTS THAT REQUIRE FURTHER MACHINING, CASTING, AND/OR FABRICATING INTO SHEET, EXTRUSIONS, FORGINGS OR OTHER SHAPES IN ORDER TO MEET THE SPECIFICATIONS OF THE END USER. BERYLLIUM AND HIGH BERYLLIUM ALLOYS WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THIS INVESTIGATION ARE CLASSIFIABLE UNDER THE HARMONIZED TARIFF SCHEDULE OF THE UNITED STATES (HTSUS) 8112.11.6000, 8112.11.3000, 7601.20.9075, AND 7601.20.9090. ALTHOUGH THE HTSUS SUBHEADINGS ARE PROVIDED FOR CONVENIENCE AND CUSTOMS PURPOSES, OUR WRITTEN DESCRIPTION OF THE SCOPE OF THIS INVESTIGATION IS DISPOSITIVE.

3. FOR FURTHER REPORTING PURPOSES, THIS CASE HAS BEEN ASSIGNED INVESTIGATION NUMBER A-834-805. FOR CUSTOMS PURPOSES ONLY, THE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER IS A-463-405.

4. FIELD OFFICES SHOULD DISCONTINUE SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION OF ALL SHIPMENTS OF THIS MERCHANDISE ENTERED OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER MARCH 5, 1997. ALL ESTIMATED DUTIES DEPOSITED ON ENTRY SUMMARIES OF THE SUBJECT MERCHANDISE SHALL BE REFUNDED AND THE BONDS OR OTHER SECURITY RELEASED AT THE TIME OF THE LIQUIDATION.

5. INTEREST PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930 DO NOT APPLY.

6.
