RE: Notice of a negative final determination in the countervailing duty investigation of circular welded carbon-quality steel pipe from the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (C-552-810)

1. On 10/22/2012, Commerce published in the Federal Register its negative final determination in the countervailing duty investigation of circular welded carbon-quality steel pipe from the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (77 FR 64471).
2. The products covered by this investigation are described in message 1327311 dated 11/23/2011.
3. This investigation has been assigned investigation number C-552-810.
4. Commerce found that a subsidy rate of zero percent exists with respect to circular welded carbon-quality steel pipe from the Socialist Republic of Vietnam. Accordingly, CBP is directed to terminate the suspension of liquidation for shipments of subject merchandise entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 03/30/2012, to release any bond or other security, and to refund any cash deposits. The interest provisions of section 778 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, do not apply.
5. Notice of the lifting of suspension of liquidation of entries of merchandise entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 03/30/2012 occurred with the publication of the notice of final determination of investigation (77 FR 64471, 10/22/2012).
