1. ON MAY 19, 1997, THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE PUBLISHED IN THE  
FEDERAL REGISTER ITS FINAL DETERMINATION OF SALES AT LESS THAN  
FAIR VALUE IN THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION OF PERSULFATES  
FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA.

2. THE PRODUCTS COVERED BY THIS INVESTIGATION ARE PERSULFATES  
INCLUDING AMMONIUM, POTASSIUM, AND SODIUM PERSULFATES. THE  
CHEMICAL FORMULAE FOR THESE PERSULFATES ARE, RESPECTIVELY, (NH<sub>4</sub>)  
2S<sub>2</sub>O<sub>8</sub>, K<sub>2</sub>S<sub>2</sub>O<sub>8</sub>, AND NA<sub>2</sub>S<sub>2</sub>O<sub>8</sub>. AMMONIUM AND POTASSIUM PERSULFATES

ARE CURRENTLY CLASSIFIED UNDER SUBHEADING 2833.40.60 OF THE HARMONIZED TARIFF SCHEDULE OF THE UNITED STATES ("HTSUS"). SODIUM PERSULFATE IS CLASSIFIED UNDER HTSUS SUBHEADING 2833.40.20. ALTHOUGH THE HTSUS SUBHEADINGS ARE PROVIDED FOR CONVENIENCE AND CUSTOMS PURPOSES, OUR WRITTEN DESCRIPTION OF THE SCOPE OF THIS INVESTIGATION IS DISPOSITIVE.

3. FOR FURTHER REPORTING PURPOSES THIS CASE HAS BEEN ASSIGNED INVESTIGATION NUMBER A-570-847.

4. FOR IMPORTS OF PERSULFATES, THE CUSTOMS SERVICE SHALL CONTINUE TO SUSPEND LIQUIDATION OF SUCH SHIPMENTS THAT ARE ENTERED OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER

DECEMBER 27, 1996. EFFECTIVE MAY 19, 1997, CUSTOMS SHALL REQUIRE, FOR SUCH ENTRY SUMMARIES, A CASH DEPOSIT OR THE POSTING OF A BOND EQUAL TO THE MARGINS RATES SHOWN BELOW:
