RE: Notice of affirmative final determination in the countervailing duty investigation of Circular Welded Carbon-Quality Steel Pipe from the United Arab Emirates (C-520-806)

1. On October 22, 2012, Commerce published in the Federal Register its affirmative final determination in the countervailing duty investigation of circular welded carbon-quality steel pipe from the United Arab Emirates (77 FR 64465).
2. The products covered by this investigation are described in message 1327308 dated 11/23/2011.
3. This investigation has been assigned investigation number C-520-806.
4. For imports of circular welded carbon-quality steel pipe from the United Arab Emirates, CBP shall suspend liquidation of such shipments entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 10/22/2012. Effective 10/22/2012, CBP shall require, for such entries, a cash deposit or the posting of a bond equal to the subsidy rates for the companies listed below:

Producer and/or exporter: Universal Tube and Plastic Industries, Ltd.

Subsidy Rate: 2.06%

Producer and/or exporter: Universal Tube and Pipe Industries LLC

5. In accordance with T.D. 85-145, at the discretion of CBP, CBP officers may accept either a single-entry basic importation and entry bond or a continuous basic importation and entry bond only if the amount of the estimated antidumping duty is less than five percent ad valorem (or the equivalent). Otherwise, where the importer has the option to post a bond for estimated antidumping duties, CBP officers must require a single-entry basic importation and entry bond pursuant to T.D. 85-145. You are instructed to adhere to the requirements of T.D. 85-145 with respect to these bonding requirements.
