RE: Injunction on mushrooms from the People's Republic of China for the period 02/01/2010 thru 01/31/2011 for Blue Field (Sichuan) Food Industrial Co., Ltd. (A-570-851), court number 12-00320

1. On 10/15/2012, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction enjoining liquidation of certain entries which are subject to the antidumping duty order on certain preserved mushrooms from the People's Republic of China (A-570-851) for the period 02/01/2010 through 01/31/2011.
2. This injunction was issued in connection with court case number 12-00320 and enjoins liquidation of the entries described in paragraph 3 below.
3. Accordingly, until further notice, do not liquidate entries of subject merchandise which were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 02/01/2010 through and including 01/31/2011; that were exported from the People's Republic of China by Blue Field (Sichuan) Food Industrial Co., Ltd.; and were the subject of the administrative determination published as Certain Preserved Mushrooms from the People's Republic of China: Final Results of Antidumping Duty Administrative Review, 77 Fed. Reg. 55808 (09/11/2012). Any entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. The injunction applies to the liquidation instructions in message number 2271301 dated 09/27/2012.
5. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to prevent liquidation of any entries subject to the above.
6. The above-referenced injunction does not require service to take effect. Pursuant to the terms of the injunction, no liquidation of the entries covered by the injunction for entries that remain unliquidated as of 10/15/2012.
