1. THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE ISSUED AMENDED LIQUIDATION INSTRUCTIONS IN MESSAGE 9029111 ON JANUARY 29, 1999 IN THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW OF CERTAIN CORROSION-RESISTANT CARBON STEEL FLAT PRODUCTS FROM AUSTRALIA PRODUCED BY THE BROKEN HILL PROPRIETARY COMPANY, LTD. (BHP). THIS IS A CORRECTION OF THOSE INSTRUCTIONS. PLEASE LIQUIDATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS CORRECTION, AS DESCRIBED IN THE NEXT PARAGRAPH.

2. THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE INADVERTENTLY INCLUDED THE WRONG CONSUMPTION PERIOD IN PARAGRAPH 3. THE CORRECTED PARAGRAPH 3 READS AS FOLLOWS:

FOR SHIPMENTS OF CORROSION-RESISTANT CARBON STEEL FLAT PRODUCTS FROM AUSTRALIA EXPORTED BY BHP AND IMPORTED BY ITS SUBSIDIARIES BHP TRADING, BHP COATED, AND BHP BUILDING PRODUCTS ENTERED OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE FOR CONSUMPTION

DURING THE PERIOD 02/04/1993 THROUGH 07/31/1994, ASSESS ANTIDUMPING LIABILITIES ON A PER-UNIT BASIS AS FOLLOWS:

FOR ALL OTHER SHIPMENTS OF CORROSION-RESISTANT CARBON STEEL FLAT PRODUCTS FROM AUSTRALIA EXPORTED BY BHP (A-602-803) ENTERED OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE FOR CONSUMPTION DURING THE PERIOD 02/04/1993 THROUGH 07/31/1994, ASSESS ANTIDUMPING LIABILITIES ON A PER-UNIT BASIS AS FOLLOWS:

3. THESE INSTRUCTIONS CONSTITUTE THE IMMEDIATE CORRECTION OF MESSAGE 9029111 ON JANUARY 29, 1999 FOR THE MERCHANDISE AND PERIOD LISTED ABOVE. PLEASE RELIQUIDATE THE ENTRIES COVERED BY PARAGRAPH 3 OF MESSAGE 9029111 ON JANUARY 29, 1999 IN ACCORDANCE WITH CORRECTED PARAGRAPH 3, AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH 2 ABOVE.

4. THE ASSESSMENT OF ANTIDUMPING DUTIES BY THE CUSTOMS SERVICE ON SHIPMENTS OR ENTRIES OF THIS MERCHANDISE IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930.

SECTION 778 REQUIRES THAT CUSTOMS PAY INTEREST ON OVERPAYMENTS, OR ASSESS INTEREST ON UNDER PAYMENTS, OF THE REQUIRED AMOUNTS DEPOSITED AS ESTIMATED COUNTERVAILING DUTIES. THE INTEREST PROVISIONS ARE NOT APPLICABLE TO CASH OR BONDS POSTED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES BEFORE THE DATE OF PUBLICATION OF THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER. INTEREST SHALL BE CALCULATED FROM THE DATE OF PAYMENT OF ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES THROUGH THE DATE OF LIQUIDATION. THE RATE AT WHICH SUCH INTEREST IS PAYABLE IS THE RATE IN EFFECT UNDER SECTION 6621 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1954 FOR SUCH PERIOD.
