RE: Preliminary injunction on sodium hexametaphosphate for Hubei Xingfa Chemical Group Co., Ltd. from the People's Republic of China for the period 3/1/10-2/28/11 (A-570-908), court number 12-00311

1. On 10/10/12, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction enjoining liquidation of certain entries which are subject to the antidumping duty order on sodium hexametaphosphate from the People's Republic of China (A-570-908) for the period 3/1/10 2/28/11.
2. This injunction was issued in connection with court case number 12-00311 and enjoins liquidation of the entries described in paragraph 3 below.
3. Accordingly, until further notice, do not liquidate entries of subject merchandise which were exported by Hubei Xingfa Chemical Group Co., Ltd., and which were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption during the period 3/1/10 through 2/28/11. Any entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by the injunction have not yet been issued.
5. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to prevent liquidation of any entries subject to the above.
6. Commerce's APO Docket Center was served with the above-referenced injunction on 10/11/12. Pursuant to the terms of the injunction, no liquidation of the entries covered by the injunction may be made for entries which remain unliquidated as of 10/10/12 after which copies of this order are personally served on Commerce's APO Docket Center.
