THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE PUBLISHED IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER (64 FR 26934) ON MAY 18, 1999, THE FINAL RESULTS OF ITS ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW OF THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER ON PORCELAIN-ON-STEEL COOKWARE FROM MEXICO FOR THE PERIOD OF DECEMBER 1, 1996 THROUGH NOVEMBER 30, 1997. THE DEPARTMENT PUBLISHED

ITS AMENDED FINAL RESULTS ON JUNE 1, 1999 (64 FR 29262).

2. FOR SHIPMENTS OF PORCELAIN-ON-STEEL COOKWARE FROM MEXICO ENTERED,

OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER JUNE 1, 1999,

A NEW CASH DEPOSIT RATE IS IN EFFECT FOR THE FOLLOWING
MANUFACTURERS/EXPORTERS:

THE RATE PROVIDED IN THE ANTIDUMPING/COUNTERVAILING DUTY MODULE.

4. THESE CASH DEPOSIT REQUIREMENTS WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL
PUBLICATION OF THE FINAL RESULTS FOR THE NEXT ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW OR
ISSUANCE OF REVISED INSTRUCTIONS FOR THIS REVIEW. DO NOT LIQUIDATE ANY
ENTRIES COVERED BY THIS REVIEW UNTIL YOU HAVE RECEIVED APPROPRIATE
LIQUIDATION INSTRUCTIONS.

5. IN ADDITION, ON MAY 18, 1999, CINSA AND ENASA FILED A REQUEST FOR
PANEL REVIEW PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 1904 OF THE NORTH AMERICAN FREE TRADE
AGREEMENT AND 19 U.S.C. SECTION 1516A(G). CINSA AND ENASA ALSO
REQUESTED THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE INSTRUCT THE U.S. CUSTOMS
SERVICE TO CONTINUE THE SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION OF ALL CINSA AND
ENASA ENTRIES OF PORCELAIN-ON-STEEL COOKWARE MADE DURING THE
ABOVE-REFERENCED REVIEW PERIOD, PENDING THE FINAL DISPOSITION OF
NAFTA PANEL REVIEW PROCEDURES.

6. ACCORDINGLY, SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION SHALL BE CONTINUED FOR
ENTRIES OF PORCELAIN-ON-STEEL COOKWARE FROM MEXICO MADE DURING THE

PERIOD DECEMBER 1, 1996, THROUGH NOVEMBER 30, 1997, AND MANUFACTURED BY
CINSA OR ENASA.
