1. THIS IS A CLARIFICATION REGARDING THE APPLICATION OF ANTIDUMPING DUTIES ON THE RETURN OF UNITED STATES GOODS CLASSIFIED UNDER THE HEADINGS 8542.13.8037 THROUGH 8542.13.8049, 8473.30.10 THROUGH 8473.30.90, AND 8542.13.8005 OF THE HARMONIZED TARIFF SCHEDULE OF THE UNITED STATES (HTSUS).

2. THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE HAS DETERMINED THAT MERCHANDISE COVERED UNDER THE ABOVE ANTIDUMPING ORDER (CLASSIFIED UNDER THE HEADINGS 8542.13.8037 THROUGH 8542.13.8049, 8473.30.10 THROUGH

8473.30.90, AND 8542.13.8005 HTSUS) THAT ENTERED THE UNITED STATES BEFORE THE DUTY ORDER WENT INTO EFFECT IS NOT SUBJECT TO ANTIDUMPING DUTIES ON ANY SUBSEQUENT IMPORTATION INTO THE UNITED STATES, CONTINGENT UPON THE IMPORTER'S ABILITY TO DEMONSTRATE TO THE SATISFACTION OF CUSTOMS THAT THE MERCHANDISE ENTERING IN THE SECOND IMPORTATION IS THE SAME MERCHANDISE THAT ENTERED IN THE FIRST IMPORTATION.

3. THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE HAS ALSO DETERMINED THAT, IF MERCHANDISE COVERED UNDER THE ABOVE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER IS IMPORTED AND SUBJECT TO ANTIDUMPING DUTIES, THEN EXPORTED FOR FURTHER PROCESSING AND SUBSEQUENTLY IMPORTED AGAIN, THE MERCHANDISE IS NOT SUBJECT TO THE COLLECTION OF ANTIDUMPING DUTIES AT THE TIME OF THE SECOND IMPORTATION. THIS IS ALSO CONTINGENT UPON THE IMPORTER'S ABILITY TO DEMONSTRATE TO THE SATISFACTION OF CUSTOMS THAT THE MERCHANDISE ENTERING IN THE SECOND IMPORTATION IS THE SAME MERCHANDISE THAT ENTERED IN THE FIRST IMPORTATION.
