RE: Preliminary injunction on certain frozen warmwater shrimp from China for the period 02/01/2010 through 01/31/2011 for Zhanjiang Regal Integrated Marine Resources Co., Ltd., (A-570-893)

1. On 09/24/2012, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction enjoining liquidation of certain entries which are subject to the antidumping duty order on certain frozen warmwater shrimp from the People's Republic of China (A-570-893) for the period 02/01/2010 through 01/31/2011.

2. This injunction was issued in connection with court case number 12-00290 and enjoins liquidation of the entries described in paragraph 3 below.

3. Accordingly, until further notice, do not liquidate entries of subject merchandise which were exported by Zhanjiang Regal Integrated Marine Resources Co., Ltd., and which were entered, or were withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 02/01/2010 through and including 01/31/2011. Any entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.

4. The injunction applies to the liquidation instructions in message number 2263308 dated 09/19/2012.

5. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to prevent liquidation of any entries subject to the above.

6. Commerce's APO Docket Center was served with the above-referenced injunction on 09/25/2012. Pursuant to the terms of the injunction, no liquidation of the entries covered by the injunction may be made for entries which remain unliquidated as of 5 o'clock p.m. of the day upon which copies of this order are personally served on Commerce's APO Docket Center.
