RE: Preliminary injunction on Seamless Refined Copper Pipe and Tube from the People's Republic of China ("PRC") for the period 11/01/2011 through 10/31/2012 (A-570-964), court number 14-00117

1. On 05/16/2014, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction enjoining liquidation of certain entries which are subject to the antidumping duty order on Seamless Refined Copper Pipe and Tube from the PRC (A-570-964) for the period 11/01/2011 through 10/31/2012.

2. This injunction was issued in connection with court number 14-00117 and enjoins liquidation of the entries described in paragraph 3 below.

3. Accordingly, until further notice, do not liquidate entries of subject merchandise which were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption during the period November 1, 2011 through October 31, 2012, inclusive; were the subject of the antidumping duty administrative review, the final results of which were published as Seamless Refined Copper Pipe and Tube from the People's Republic of China: Final Results of Antidumping Duty Administrative Review; 2011-2012, 79 Fed. Reg. 23,324 (Dep't of Commerce Apr. 28, 2014) and accompanying Issues and Decision Memorandum ("Contested Determination"); and were exported by Golden Dragon Precise Copper Tube Group, Inc., Hong Kong GD Trading Co., Ltd., and Golden Dragon Holding (Hong Kong) International, Ltd. (collectively, "Golden Dragon"). Any entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.

4. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by the injunction have not yet been issued.

5. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to prevent liquidation of any entries subject to the above.

6. Pursuant to the terms of the injunction, no liquidation of the entries covered by the injunction may be made for entries which remain unliquidated as of 05/16/2014.
