RE: Antidumping duty scope determination on Polyethylene Terephthalate film, sheet, and strip from Brazil (A-351-841)

Notice of the lifting of suspension occurred on the message date of these instructions. See paragraph 5 below.

1. Commerce received a scope ruling request from Evertis Packaging Solutions. Commerce issued a final scope determination on 05/02/2014 that certain Evertis Packaging Solutions' Ecoblock C products produced in thicknesses of either 14 millimeters or 16 millimeters which Evertis Packaging Solutions imports is not within the scope of the antidumping duty order on polyethylene terephthalate (PET) film, sheet, and strip from Brazil (A-351-841).
2. Commerce determined that Evertis Packaging Solutions' Ecoblock C products produced in thicknesses of either 14 millimeters or 16 millimeters are outside the scope if they are amorphous PET films which are not biaxially-oriented, and contain no biaxially-oriented PET. Therefore, Evertis Packaging Solutions' Ecoblock C products meeting these criteria are not within the scope of the antidumping duty order on PET film, sheet, and strip from Brazil.
3. For all entries of Evertis Packaging Solutions' Ecoblock C products meeting the criteria in paragraph 2 not within scope that remain unliquidated on or after 05/05/2008, CBP shall terminate suspension and liquidate entries of product not within scope which were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption.
4. Refund any cash deposits relating to Evertis Packaging Solutions' Ecoblock C products described in paragraph 2 above.
5. These instructions constitute notice of the lifting of suspension of liquidation of entries of Evertis Packaging Solutions' Ecoblock C products described in paragraph 2 above entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 05/05/2008.
6. The assessment of antidumping duties by CBP on shipments or entries of this merchandise is subject to the provisions of section 778 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended. Section 778

requires that CBP pay interest on overpayments or assess interest on underpayments of the required amounts deposited as estimated antidumping duties. The interest provisions are not applicable to cash or bonds posted as estimated antidumping duties before the date of publication of the antidumping duty order. Interest shall be calculated from the date payment of estimated antidumping duties is required through the date of liquidation. The rate at which such interest is payable is the rate in effect under section 6621 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 for such period.

7. Unless instructed otherwise, for all other shipments of PET film, sheet, and strip from Brazil not covered by paragraph 2 above, you shall continue to collect cash deposits of estimated antidumping duties for the merchandise at the current rates.
