RE: Preliminary Injunction on fresh garlic from the PRC for Chengwu County Yuanxiang Industry & Commerce Co., Ltd., for the period of 11/01/2011 through 10/31/2012 (A-570-831), ct. no. 14-00167

1. On 07/23/2014, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction enjoining liquidation of certain entries which are subject to the antidumping duty order on fresh garlic from the People's Republic of China (A-570-831) for the period 11/01/2011 through 10/31/2012.
2. This injunction was issued in connection with court case number 14-00167 and enjoins liquidation of the entries described in paragraph 3 below.
3. Accordingly, until further notice, do not liquidate entries of subject merchandise from the People's Republic of China that: 1) were exported from China by Chengwu County Yuanxiang Industry & Commerce Co., Ltd.; 2) were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption during the period November 1, 2011 through October 31, 2012; and 3) were the subject of the administrative review published as Fresh Garlic from the People's Republic of China: Final Results and Partial Rescission of the 18th Antidumping Duty Administrative Review, 79 Fed. Reg. 36,721 (June 30, 2014). Any entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by the injunction have not yet been issued.
5. Effective immediately, United States Customs and Border Protection (CBP) is instructed to prevent liquidation of any entries subject to the above.
6. Commerce's APO Docket Center was served with the above-referenced injunction on 07/23/2014. This was issued on 07/23/2014. Pursuant to the terms of the injunction, no liquidation of the entries covered by the injunction may be made for entries which remain unliquidated effective on the day on which this order was issued, 7/23/2014.
