RE: Notice of final determination in the antidumping duty investigation of ferrosilicon from Venezuela (A-307-824)

1. On 07/31/2014, Commerce published in the Federal Register (79 FR 44397) its final affirmative determination of sales at less-than-fair-value in the antidumping duty investigation of ferrosilicon from Venezuela (A-307-824).
2. The products covered by this investigation are described in message 3228308, dated 08/16/2013.
3. This investigation has been assigned investigation number A-307-824.
4. For imports of ferrosilicon from Venezuela, CBP shall continue to suspend liquidation of such shipments entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 07/31/2014. Effective 07/31/2014, CBP shall require, for such entries, a cash deposit equal to the margins for the producer and/or exporter listed below:

Producer and/or Exporter: FerroAtlantica de Venezuela

Case number: A-307-824-001

Cash deposit rate: 22.84%

All Others

Case Number: A-307-824-000

Cash Deposit Rate: 22.84%

5. If any entries of this merchandise are exported by a firm other than the producer, then the following instructions apply:

A. If the exporter of the subject merchandise does not have its own rate but the producer has its own rate, the cash deposit will be the producer's rate.

B. Where neither the exporter nor the producer currently has its own rate or the producer is

unknown, use the all-others rate of 22.84 percent to establish the cash deposit rate.
