RE: Liquidation following notification of ITC negative determination of critical circumstances for certain oil country tubular goods from India for All Others (C-533-858-000)

1. On 09/02/2014, the U.S. International Trade Commission (ITC) determined that critical circumstances do not exist with respect to oil country tubular goods (OCTG) from India. As a result of the ITC's negative determination of critical circumstances, CBP should terminate the suspension of liquidation for all shipments of OCTG from India, produced and/or exported by All Others (C-533-858-000) that were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 09/24/2013 (which is 90 days prior to the date of publication of the preliminary determination (78 FR 77421, 12/23/2013)) through 12/22/2013. All such entries should be liquidated without regard to countervailing duties (i.e., return all cash-deposits).
2. Notice of the lifting of suspension of liquidation of entries of merchandise entered or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption before 12/23/2013 (the date of publication of Commerce's preliminary determination notice in the Federal Register) occurred with the publication of the ITC final determination of its investigation (79 FR 53080, 09/05/2014). For all other shipments of OCTG from India, continue to collect cash deposits of estimated countervailing duties for the merchandise at the current rates unless instructed otherwise.
3. The interest provisions of section 778 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, do not apply.
4.
