RE: Preliminary injunction on PET film from the PRC for DuPont Teijin Films China Limited et al. for the period 11/01/2011 through 10/31/2012 (A-570-924), consol. court number 14-00183

1. On 09/18/2014, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction (PI) enjoining liquidation of entries identified in paragraph 2 which are subject to the antidumping duty order on polyethylene terephthalate film, sheet, and strip from the People's Republic of China (A-570-924) for the period 11/01/2011 through 10/31/2012. This PI was issued in connection with consol. court number 14-00183.
2. This PI enjoins liquidation of entries which (1) were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption during the period 11/01/2011 through 10/31/2012, inclusive;(2) were the subject to the antidumping duty administrative review, the final results of which were published as Polyethylene Terephthalate Film, Sheet, and Strip from the People's Republic of China, 79 Fed. Reg. 37,715 (Dep't of Commerce July 2, 2014) (final results admin. review) and accompanying Issues and Decision Memorandum, A-570-924 (Dep't of Commerce June 24, 2014); and (3) were exported by DuPont Teijin Films China Limited, DuPont Hongji Films Foshan Co., Ltd., or DuPont Teijin Films Hongji Ningbo Co., Ltd.
3. Effective 09/18/2014 (the date the Court issued the PI), no liquidation may be made for entries referred to in paragraph 2 which remain unliquidated. Any such entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to follow the terms of the PI.
5. The PI applies to the liquidation instructions in message number 4224301, dated 08/12/2014.
