RE: Amended Preliminary Injunction on diamond sawblades and parts thereof from the Republic of Korea for the periods 01/23/2009 - 10/31/2010 or 11/01/2010 - 10/23/2011 (A-580-855), court number 06-00248

1. On 09/10/2014, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction (PI) enjoining liquidation of entries identified in paragraph 2 which are subject to the antidumping duty order on diamond sawblades and parts thereof from the Republic of Korea (A-580-855) for the periods 01/23/2009 through 10/31/2010 or 11/01/2010 through 10/23/2011. On 10/24/2014, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued an amended PI preliminary injunction. This amended PI was issued in connection with court number 06-00248.

2. This amended PI enjoins liquidation of entries which:

1. were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption for the period January 23, 2009, through October 31, 2010, or for the period November 1, 2010 through October 23, 2011;

2. were ordered by the Department of Commerce to be liquidated by U.S. Customs and Border Protection pursuant to message 4162301, dated June 11, 2014, or message 4175304, dated June 24, 2014;

3. were produced and/or exported by Hyosung Diamond Industrial Co., Ltd., Western Diamond Tools Inc. or Hyosung D&P Co., Ltd; and

4. remain unliquidated as September 10, 2014.

3. Effective 09/10/2014, no liquidation may be made for entries referred to in paragraph 2 which remain unliquidated as of 09/10/2014. Any such entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.

4. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to follow the terms of the amended PI.

5. The amended PI applies to the liquidation instructions in message numbers 4162301, dated 06/11/2014, and 4175304, dated 06/24/2014.
