RE: Liquidation following notification of ITC negative determination of critical circumstances for steel concrete reinforcing bar from the Republic of Turkey (C-489-819)

1. This message pertains to the critical circumstances determination. On 09/15/2014, Commerce published in the Federal Register (79 FR 54963) its final affirmative countervailing duty determination and affirmative finding of critical circumstances in the countervailing duty investigation of steel concrete reinforcing bar (rebar) from the Republic of Turkey (Turkey) (C-489-819). Commerce determined that critical circumstances existed for certain imports of rebar from Turkey. Accordingly, in message number 4266306, dated 09/23/2014, Commerce instructed CBP to suspend liquidation of such shipments that were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 06/17/2014, which is 90 days before the date on which suspension of liquidation was first ordered for such entries. In addition, for such merchandise entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption during this period, Commerce instructed CBP to require a cash deposit.

2. On 11/03/2014, the International Trade Commission (ITC) determined that critical circumstances do not exist with respect to subject imports from Turkey (79 FR 65246). Accordingly, CBP should terminate the suspension of liquidation of rebar entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption before 09/15/2014, and liquidate the entries without regard to countervailing duties (i.e., refund all cash deposits).

3. Notice of lifting of suspension of liquidation of entries entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption before 09/15/2014 (the date of publication of Commerce's final determination notice in the Federal Register) occurred on 11/03/2014, the date of the publication of the ITC's final determination of its investigation (79 FR 65246). For all other shipments of rebar from Turkey, continue to collect cash deposits of estimated countervailing duties for the merchandise at the current rates unless instructed otherwise.

4. The interest provisions of section 778 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, do not apply.
