RE: Final results of changed circumstances review - Certain Polyester Staple Fiber from the Republic of Korea (A-580-839)

1. On 12/22/2014, Commerce published in the Federal Register (79 FR 76301) its final results in the changed circumstances review of the antidumping duty order on Certain Polyester Staple Fiber from the Republic of Korea (A-580-839).

2. The Department finds that Toray Chemical Korea Inc. is the successor-in-interest to Woongjin Chemical Co., Ltd.

3. Accordingly, for shipments of Certain Polyester Staple Fiber from the Republic of Korea which were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 12/22/2014, CBP shall require a cash deposit for estimated antidumping duties at the following rate:

Toray Chemical Korea Inc.

Case number: A-580-839-017

Cash deposit rate: 2.13%

4. This cash deposit requirement shall remain in effect until further notice. Do not liquidate any entries of this merchandise until specific liquidation instructions are issued.
