RE: Liquidation instructions for Polyethylene Retail Carrier Bags from Taiwan for the period 07/31/2013 through 04/30/2014 (A-583-843)

1. Commerce issued automatic liquidation instructions for the administrative review of this order covering the period 05/01/2013 through 04/30/2014. Accordingly, Commerce issued liquidation instructions covering all entries of subject merchandise during this period of review. See message 4198301, dated 07/17/2014.

2. Meanwhile, on 06/02/2014 (79 FR 31302), Commerce issued an affirmative preliminary determination of circumvention of the order, which covered merchandise from Taiwan that appears ready to undergo the final processing of cutting the unfinished polyethylene retail carrier bag to length, sealing the bottoms, and die-cutting the unfinished polyethylene retail carrier bags to create the handles of the finished polyethylene retail carrier bags. The unfinished polyethylene retail carrier bags subject to this inquiry may or may not have printing and may be of different dimensions as long as they meet the description of the scope of the order. For such imports subject to the anticircumvention inquiry, entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 07/31/2013 (the date of initiation of the anticircumvention inquiry), Commerce instructed CBP to suspend liquidation and require a cash deposit at the rate applicable for the antidumping duty order for each exporter. See message 4197307, dated 07/16/2014.

3. On 10/09/2014 (79 FR 61056), Commerce issued an affirmative final determination of circumvention finding that imports of unfinished polyethylene retail carrier bags from Taiwan, meeting the description of the merchandise covered by the circumvention inquiry as described in paragraph 2 above, are subject to the antidumping duty order on polyethylene retail carrier bags from Taiwan. For such imports entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 07/31/2013 (the date of initiation of the anticircumvention inquiry), Commerce continued to instruct CBP to suspend liquidation and require a cash deposit at the rate applicable for the antidumping duty order for each exporter. See message 4283309, dated 10/10/2014.

4. Based on the above, CBP is directed to liquidate the unliquidated entries of unfinished polyethylene retail carrier bags from Taiwan, meeting the description of the merchandise covered by the circumvention inquiry as described in paragraph 2 above, entered, or withdrawn from

warehouse, for consumption on or after 07/31/2013 through 04/30/2014. For such entries, assess antidumping duties at the cash deposit or bonding rate in effect on the date of entry. The amount deposited (if any) at entry and the final assessment rate may differ.

5. Notice of the lifting of suspension of entries of subject merchandise covered by paragraph 4 occurred with the publication of the final determination of circumvention 10/09/2014 (79 FR 61056). Unless instructed otherwise, for all other shipments of subject merchandise covered by paragraph 2 you shall continue to collect cash deposits of estimated antidumping duties for the merchandise at the current rates.
