RE: Antidumping duty scope determination on certain circular welded non-alloy steel pipe from Mexico (A-201-805)

Notice of the lifting of suspension occurred with message 5016305, dated 01/16/2015. See paragraph 5 below.

1. Commerce received a scope ruling request from Productos Laminados de Monterrey, S.A. de C.V. On 12/03/2014, Commerce issued a preliminary scope determination that Productos Laminados de Monterrey, S.A. de C.V.'s ASTM A-513 mechanical tubing which Productos Laminados de Monterrey, S.A. de C.V. exports is not within the scope of the antidumping duty order on certain circular welded non-alloy steel pipe from Mexico (A-201-805) (see message 5016305). Commerce issued a final scope determination on 01/12/2015 that Productos Laminados de Monterrey, S.A. de C.V.'s ASTM A-513 mechanical tubing which Productos Laminados de Monterrey, S.A. de C.V. exports is not within the scope of the antidumping duty order on certain circular welded non-alloy steel pipe from Mexico (A-201-805).

2. Commerce determined that Productos Laminados de Monterrey, S.A. de C.V.'s ASTM A-513 mechanical tubing is outside the scope of the order when they are circular tubes that are neither galvanized nor coated with zinc, and are single stenciled as ASTM A-513, and meet the ASTM A-513 specification for "as welded tubing," and either:

(a) do not overlap with the diameter and wall thickness combinations (i.e., "nominal pipe sizes") of pipe (e.g., ASTM A-53) for Schedules 10, 40, or 80; or

(b) do overlap with the diameter and wall thickness combinations (i.e., "nominal pipe sizes") of pipe (e.g., ASTM A-53) for Schedules 10, 40, or 80, and have not been hydrostatically tested, and have a carbon content not greater than 0.13 percent, and meet the Rockwell B Hardness test (that is, a minimum of 55 for grade 1010, and a minimum of 50 for lower carbon grades (e.g., 1008)), and have a minimum elongation (in 2 inches) of 24 percent for pipes and tubes with a diameter over 1.5 inches or have a minimum elongation (in 2 inches) of 15 percent for pipes and tubes with a diameter of 1.5 inches or less.

Therefore, Productos Laminados de Monterrey, S.A. de C.V.'s ASTM A-513 mechanical tubing is not within the scope of the antidumping duty order on certain circular welded non-alloy steel pipe from Mexico.

3. In continuation of Commerce's preliminary determination, for all entries of Productos Laminados de Monterrey, S.A. de C.V.'s ASTM A-513 mechanical tubing not within scope that remain unliquidated on or after 11/01/2012, CBP shall terminate suspension and liquidate entries of product not within scope which were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption.

4. In continuation of Commerce's preliminary determination, refund any cash deposits relating to Productos Laminados de Monterrey, S.A. de C.V.'s ASTM A-513 mechanical tubing described above.

5. Message 5016305 (dated 01/16/2015) constitutes notice of the lifting of suspension of liquidation of entries of the aforementioned Productos Laminados de Monterrey, S.A. de C.V. ASTM A-513 mechanical tubing from Mexico entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption on or after 11/01/2012.

6. The assessment of antidumping duties by CBP on shipments or entries of this merchandise is subject to the provisions of section 778 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended. Section 778 requires that CBP pay interest on overpayments or assess interest on underpayments of the required amounts deposited as estimated antidumping duties. The interest provisions are not applicable to cash or bonds posted as estimated antidumping duties before the date of publication of the antidumping duty order. Interest shall be calculated from the date payment of estimated antidumping duties is required through the date of liquidation. The rate at which such interest is payable is the rate in effect under section 6621 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 for such period.

7. Unless instructed otherwise, for all other shipments of certain circular welded non-alloy steel pipe from Mexico not covered by paragraph 2 above, you shall continue to collect cash deposits of estimated antidumping duties for the merchandise at the current rates.
