RE: Preliminary injunction on large power transformers from the Republic of Korea produced and/or exported by various companies for the period 02/16/2012 thru 07/31/2013 (A-580-867), court number 15-00108

1. On 04/14/2015, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction (PI) enjoining liquidation of entries identified in paragraph 2 which are subject to the antidumping duty order on large power transformers from the Republic of Korea (A-580-867) for the period 02/16/2012 through 07/31/2013. This PI was issued in connection with court number 15-00108.
2. This PI enjoins liquidation of entries of large power transformers from the Republic of Korea that were the subject of the administrative determination published as Large Power Transformers from the Republic of Korea: Final Results of Antidumping Duty Administrative Review; 2012-2013, 80 FR 17034 (March 31, 2015); were produced and/or exported by Hyosung Corporation and HICO America Sales and Technology, Inc. ("Hyosung"), Hyundai Heavy Industries Co., Ltd. and Hyundai Corporation USA ("Hyundai"), ILJIN and ILJIN Electric Co., Ltd. ("ILJIN Electric"), or LSIS Co., Ltd. ("LSIS"); and were entered into the United States, or were withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, during the period from February 16, 2012, through July 31, 2013.
3. Effective 04/14/2015 (the date the Court issued the PI), no liquidation may be made for entries referred to in paragraph 2 which remain unliquidated as of 5:00 pm 04/15/2015. Any such entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to follow the terms of the PI.
5. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by this PI have not yet been issued.
