RE: Preliminary injunction on certain steel nails from China for Xi'an Metals & Minerals Import & Export Co., Ltd. for the period 08/01/2012 through 07/31/2013 (A-570-909), court number 15-00109

1. On 04/22/2015, the U.S. Court of International Trade ("Court") issued a preliminary injunction ("PI") enjoining liquidation of entries identified in paragraph 2 which are subject to the antidumping duty order on certain steel nails from the People's Republic of China (A-570-909) for the period 08/01/2012 through 07/31/2013. This PI was issued in connection with court number 15-00109.
2. This PI enjoins liquidation of entries which are of certain steel nails from the People's Republic of China (Case No. A-570-909) that: 1) were entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption on or after August 1, 2012 through July 31, 2013; and 2) were the subject of the administrative proceeding published as Certain Steel Nails From the People's Republic of China: Final Results of Antidumping Duty Administrative Review; 2012-2013, 80 Fed. Reg. 18,816 (Dept. Of Commerce April 8, 2015); and 3) were exported by Xi'an Metals & Minerals Import & Export Co., Ltd. from the People's Republic of China to the United States; and 4) remain unliquidated as of 5:00 p.m. on the day the Court enters the order on the docket in this case.
3. Effective 04/22/2015 (the date the Court issued the PI), no liquidation may be made for entries referred to in paragraph 2 which remain unliquidated as of 5:00 p.m. 04/22/2015. Any such entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to follow the terms of the PI.
5. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by this PI have not yet been issued.
